## Attendee Event Policies – 2010

### Congratulations, Seniors! It's all for you!

#### **ATTENDEES:**

Attendees shall consist of graduating seniors of The Woodlands High School and The Woodlands College Park High School (the "Seniors") and their guests. Seniors must present a valid student ID upon entering the event. The student id will be confirmed against the official school student directory listing.

Guests of the Seniors shall be between the ages of 18 and 21 years of age and be a current or recent high school graduate. Guests must check-in concurrently with their accompanying Senior host and present a valid ID. Guests may enjoy food, drinks, games, and entertainment, but all prizes are reserved for the Seniors, only.

No underclassmen may attend.

#### **ADMISSION FEE:**

Admission fee for Seniors is \$25, prior to May 23, 2010, or \$40 after May 23, 2010. Registration is available online at: [www.operationgraduationonline.com](http://www.operationgraduationonline.com) until May 23, 2010. Limited registration-in-person will be available at school lunches during future advertised dates.

Guest admission fee is \$40. Guest registration is not available on-line, but may be purchased during the aforementioned lunch sales or at the door.

All admissions (Senior and/or Guest) at the door on the night of the event are **\$40 CASH ONLY**.

#### **BACKPACKS / BAGS / HANDBAGS / PURSES / OUTSIDE FOOD OR DRINK:**

Attendees of the event may not carry a backpack, bag, handbag, or a purse of any type into the event.

No outside food or drink is allowed.

#### **DRESS:**

Dress comfortably, but appropriately. Sweatshirts/hoodies and even long pants are encouraged for air-conditioning.

**CELLULAR TELEPHONES:**

Due to the many active physical activities available to participate in, attendees are discouraged from bringing cell phones to the event. Should an attendee decide to bring a cell phone, the phone will be the sole responsibility of the attendee.

**ATTENDEE CONDUCT:**

Each attendee is expected to:

- Behave in a responsible manner, always exercising self discipline.
- Respect the rights and privileges of other attendees and event volunteers.
- Respect the property of others, including District property and facilities.

Attendees suspected of using or having possession of alcohol or drugs will be referred to the CISD police officer on duty during the event.

**ARRIVAL AND DEPARTURE:**

The event hours are from 11:00 pm until 5:00 am. Attendees must check-in prior to midnight. Attendees will not be admitted after midnight. Attendees will remain on premises until conclusion of the event.

Attendees will only be allowed to leave the event early in cases of emergency. Early exit will require approval of the attendee's parent, and completion by said parent, or an authorized OG Staff member after a telephone conversation with said parent, of the OG Attendee Early Dismissal form. The student will be escorted by an OG Staff member out of the event to their personal vehicle or detained until a parent arrives for pickup.
